Instructional Management Plan
2014 – 2015

In accordance with District Policy (Section I, Policy Code ID) the Instructional Management Plan is a comprehensive system that links curriculum, instruction and assessment. The plan outlines all documents and resources aligned with Common Core State Standards, the PARCC Assessment System, and the College and Career Readiness Standards. These resources, which are maintained in an Instructional Management Binder, are used to guide instructional planning. Copies of the binder can be located in classrooms and the principal's office of each building.

The binder will contain:

1. The Common Core State Standards relevant to the content area(s) each teacher provides instruction for;
2. The PARCC Model Content Frameworks;
3. District Pacing Guides relevant to the content area(s) each teacher provides instruction for;
4. PARCC Blue Prints and Test Specifications;
5. Scaffolding documents that are designed to be used when differentiating instruction for students based on individual learning needs;
6. Teaching strategies to be used to enhance classroom instruction;
7. Daily lesson plans;
8. Teacher-made assessments that are aligned with Common Core State Standards and PARCC;
9. Daily bell-ringers used at the beginning of each lesson; and
10. Additional resource and websites to be used while planning instruction.

The Instructional Management binder is updated annually.
